"Future Travel- Extended" (World Premiere)

This performance will draw materials from the following compositions in an improvisatory mixture.

Future Travel (1981 & 2024 extractions) Out of Truth (Don't Motto) (2018) Is Existence Is (2024)

Future Travel is structured in seven parts linked by a narrative, a journey in sonic imagery. The future traveler, whose point of view we imagine, is a spirit being, representing the first awareness of a new form of consciousness to which humans have evolved after becoming aware of the unlikelihood of surviving the unstoppable momentum of the evolutionary course they had set earlier. This new form of awareness is a macroscopic one, a large-scale organism, to which all individual entities of earlier Earthly forms contributed. Future Travel is also the first major composition created with what was a radical new approach to building a hybrid, digital-analog keyboard instrument for its time, called Touché, which resulted from a 1979-1980 design collaboration with Donald Buchla.

Out of Truth (Don't Motto) interlaces Lewis Klahr's uniquely idiosyncratic filmic style, employing found images to explore the intersection of memory and history, with live music. The musical composition is in 17-beats with minor-key harmonic patterns thought of as evoking inquisitiveness and reflection on uncertainty. Klahr has built the film also with rhythmical ideas that enable exploring the concept of

making film be "part of the band." Lewis Klahr is a Los Angeles based filmmaker who began developing a collage style for his films in the mid-1970s. His films have been screened extensively in the U.S., Europe, and Asia. Rosenboom's music appears in a number of Klahr's films..

Is Existence Is (2024) is an evolving, ongoing, composition and performance project that can take many forms. Its sound worlds, text materials, harmonic architectures, voice parts, and projected image environments intertwine spontaneously, arising from reflections on facts and philosophies of existence: concurrent complexity dynamics linking inside with outside; the places, locations, and times of individual and other; and the resplendent emergence of pure spirit. The work is dedicated to my wife and life partner, artist, Nicki Voss.
